Open daily for lunch and dinner, guests can kick off their meals with appetizer selections including Maine Lobster Bisque, Blue Star Angus Carpaccio, Hoison Chili Calamari, Firecracker Shrimp, and Local Cedar Key Middleneck Clams. Seafood fans can also order options from the raw bar including Oysters on the Half Shell, Yellowfin Tuna Poke, and Jumbo Lump Crab and Avocado. The Boathouse menu is then broken down into several different categories of entrees. Salads options include The Wedge, Garden Salad, Buffalo Chicken, The Chopped Salad, and Caesar Salad all of which come in large and small options. Featured fish options include Grilled Mahi Mahi Tacos, Coriander Seared Ahi Tuna, Cedar Planked Salmon, and Boiled Atlantic Swordfish Steak. Guests who are looking to enjoy a sandwich can choose from options like the "Yacht Club" Club, Togarashi Tuna Burger, Steak Sandwich, and Filet Mignon Sliders. Sea & Shore menu items include options like Baked Crab Stuffed Lobster, Maine Lobster Mac N' Cheese, and Jumbo Lump Crab Cake. Those who are looking for heartier menu options can pick from the Steaks, Chops, & Provisions section from options including Filet Mignon, New York Strip, and NY Steak & Fries. Well the food at The Boathouse is amazing, guests have to

be sure to save room for delicious dessert options like Florida Sunshine Cake, Key Lime Pie, Whiskey Caramel Cornbread Cake, and Double Chocolate Bundt Cake.

1. The Amphicars

These cars begin operating on land as usual on four wheels and suddenly move down a ramp to take to the water as fully functioning boats!
